**Motion** was made by Jim Beck to approve Net Pay Account Distribution Report, seconded by Steve Dolin; motion carried.


**Motion** was made by Marvin Mathiowetz to approve Claims List for Approval Report, seconded by Jim Beck; motion carried.


**Motion** was made by Jim Beck to adjourn meeting at 9:10 p.m., seconded by Steve Dolin; motion carried.
